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


Nearly a quarter of kids aged 5-7 have smartphones

Nearly a quarter of UK five-to-seven-year-olds now have their own smartphone, research suggests.

used TikTok in 2022? Give your answer as a fraction in its simplest form.


(b) What proportion of these young people used TikTok in 2023? Give your answer as a decimal.

Lost plastic duck washes up in Orkney after 18 years

Australian farm grows world's largest blueberry

An Australian farm has smashed the record for the world's largest blueberry with a fruit the size of co

Picked in November, it has this week been certified by the Guinness World Records as the heaviest ever documented – weighing a whopping 20:4 grams! It also measured 39:31 millimetres in length.
