Attendance and punctuality

As part of our drive to continue to raise standards, we would like to request your full support to continue in ensuring that your child attends school punctually every day, and that they are fully equipped and prepared for school. Each term you will continue to receive a regular update about your child's attendance which is intended to support improvements throughout the year. As you will no doubt remember. during the pandemic, whilst online learning was in place for all students, this could not fully substitute face to face learning. It is essential therefore that students attend school fully and engage in all the opportunities school life brings. Students that miss just 10 minutes each day, miss an incredible 30 hours of teaching and learning across the year!

Additionally, holidays during term time cannot be approved. This is in line with the government's guidance to schools. Parents who choose to take holidays will receive a penalty notice from Bolton MBC. .As you will no doubt have seen in the local and national news, penalties have now increased and parents who receive multiple fines may be subject to legal action.

If your child/(ren) is unwell and will be absent from school, please email <u>attendance@msj.bolton.sch.uk</u> as soon as possible so your child's attendance record can be updated and teachers notified.

It is important to note that students who are late to school miss vital learning time which can affect the rest of the school day. Please ensure your child/(ren) arrives on time each day.

It is vital that your child attends school at 8.30am each day. Each morning at 8.30am students take part in Personal Development Time (PDT). During this lesson, a number of tailored opportunities take place for our students, including intervention for literacy and numeracy; reading, careers guidance, mentoring and coaching sessions along with the opportunity to discuss their progress with their PDT tutor. At Mount St Joseph we value Personal Development Time and can see the benefits this brings about to develop well-rounded students. We will be sending out a separate letter to all parents and carers regarding the new changes to Relationships Sex and Health Education (RSHE) lessons.

Reminders about standards:

To maintain our excellent reputation in the community, we need to ensure that uniform is of the highest standard. We did write to parents and carers before the summer break to give some reminders about the standards we expect in school. Please ensure you refer to the school website for the full school uniform list. Year group coloured lanyards must be worn at all times and are now part of the school uniform (please see colour of year group in table above). Please remind your child to bring this into school each day as they will require this to purchase lunch and breaktime snacks. Year 7 and new starters will receive a lanyard on their first day. Student planner

We will be issuing all students with a planner on their first day; this will be used by students to make a note of their timetable and record homework. Please ensure your child/(ren) bring this into school every day, as they will use their planner in lessons. There will be consequences if students fail to bring their planner on a regular basis. It is intended to ensure all students have a quick reference guide for their classes each day and any passes that students are issued will be recorded in their planners. Students who lose their planner will need to purchase a replacement.

Please note that a letter regarding homework will be sent via an email to staff and parents in the next few days.

Mobile phones

In order to build on and develop student progress and attainment, we need to focus on all aspects associated with learning, eliminating distractions for students. Here at MSJ, we have a policy that states that electronic devices should be 'Out of sight, on site'. I would like to request the support of parents and carers in reminding their child about mobile phones and other electrical devices; these should be switched off and kept out of sight during the school day, including break and lunch. Students found using any electronic devices in school will have them confiscated until the end of the school day.
