
Lord God, you are love, and in love we reach out, allowing ourselves to be touched by the joys and griefs of all your people.

As you listen to the hymn 'All Things' from the One Hope Project, remember that our hope comes from knowing that God's love for us will never end.





Often, we can treat others badly or not treat them with dignity, we pray for those around us remembering their value.






Continue to pray for others in our world
