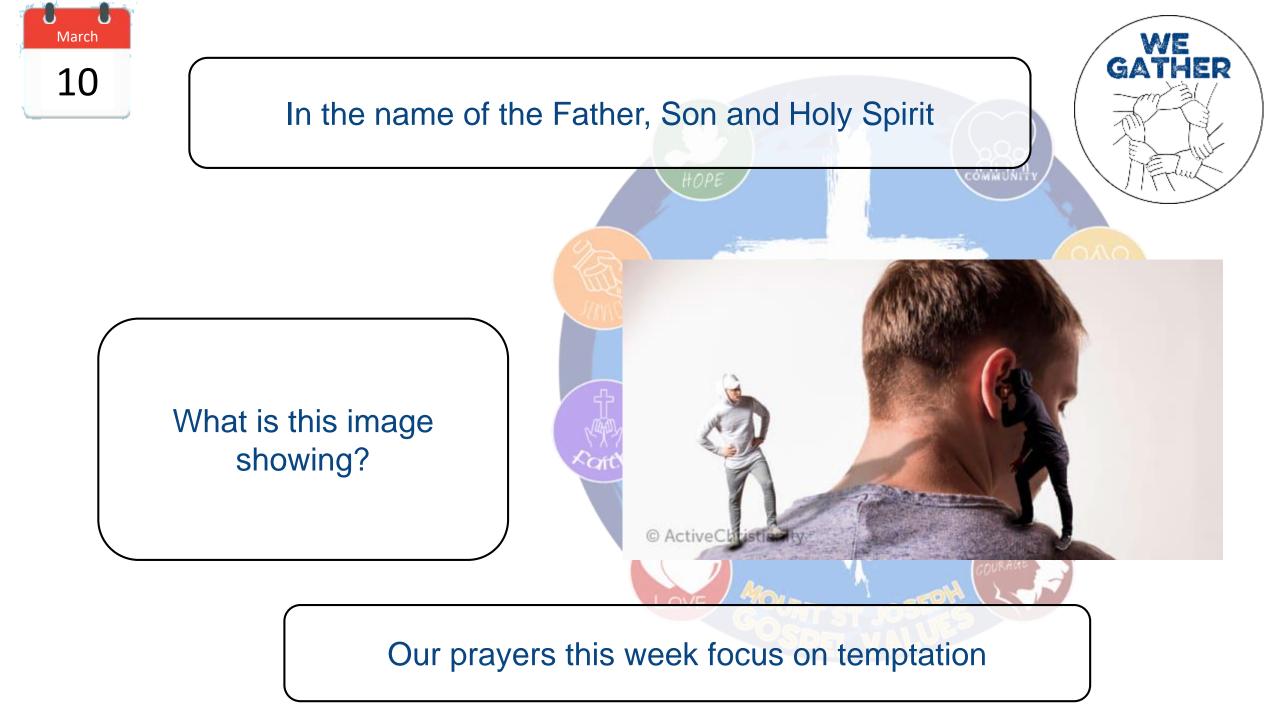

Your Father knows what you need before you ask him. This, then, is how you should pray:

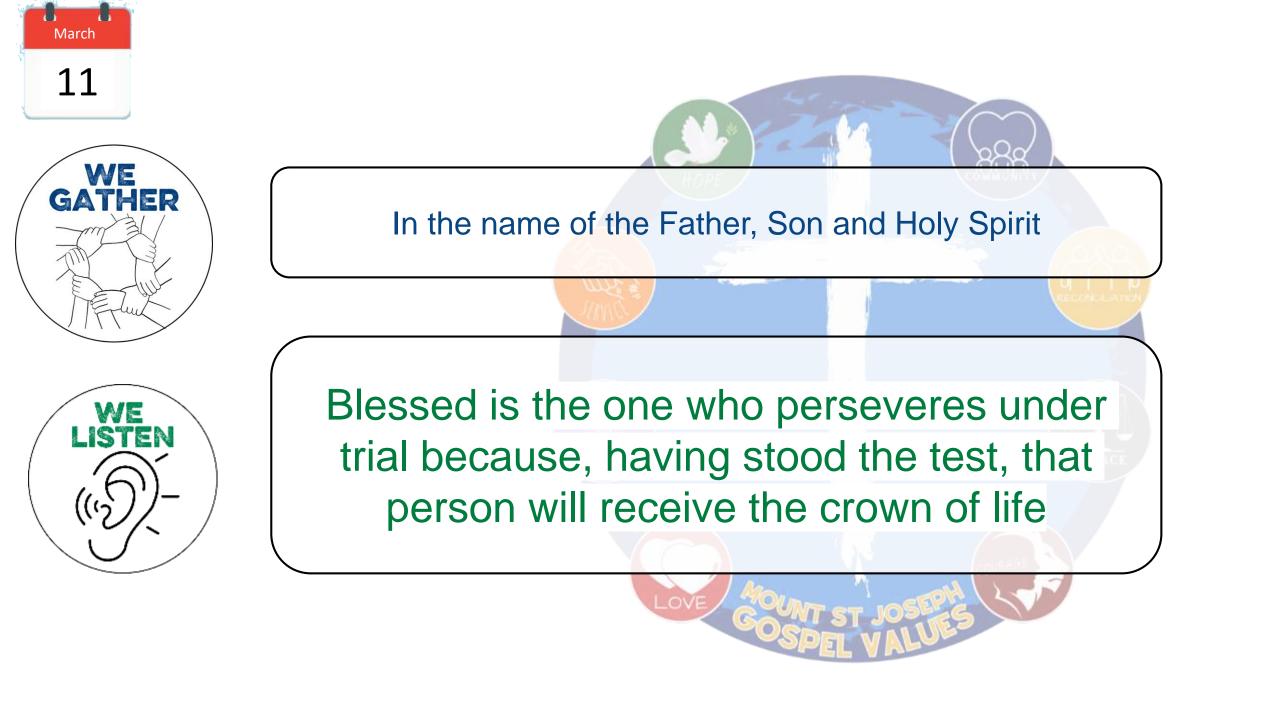
Matthew 6:8-9

How can we resist temptation?





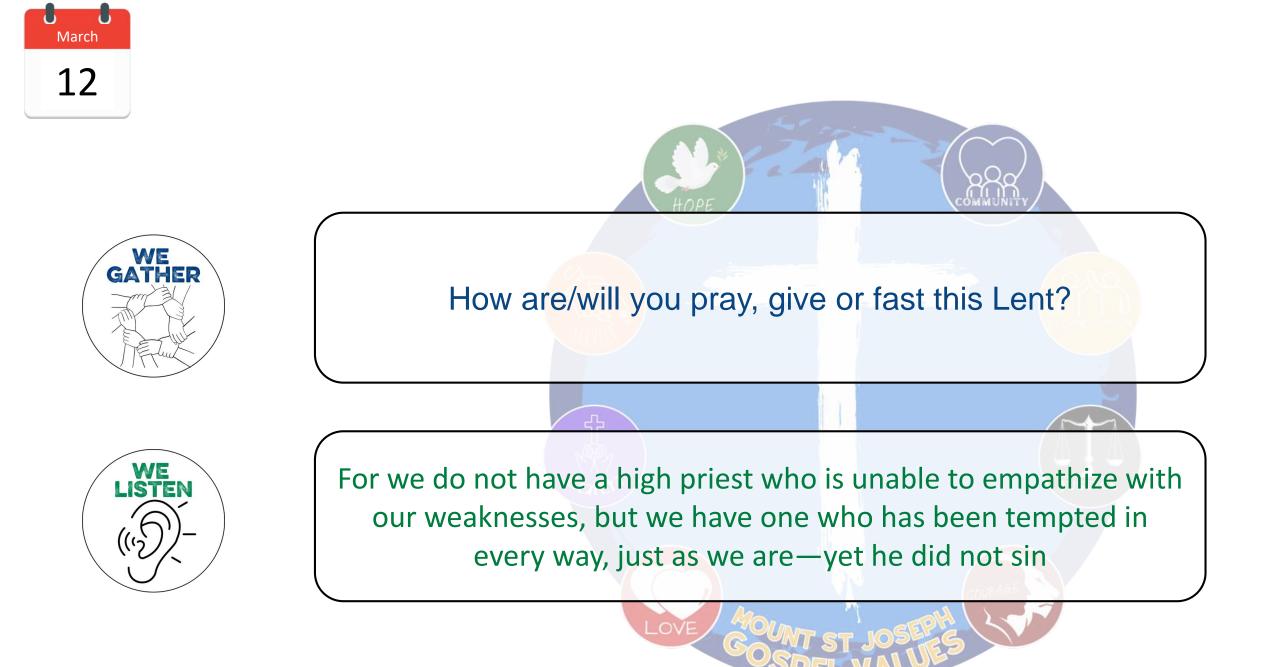


Spend a couple of minutes in silent reflection, thinking about the challenges and temptations we face, giving them to God.

Write your promise on the sheet.

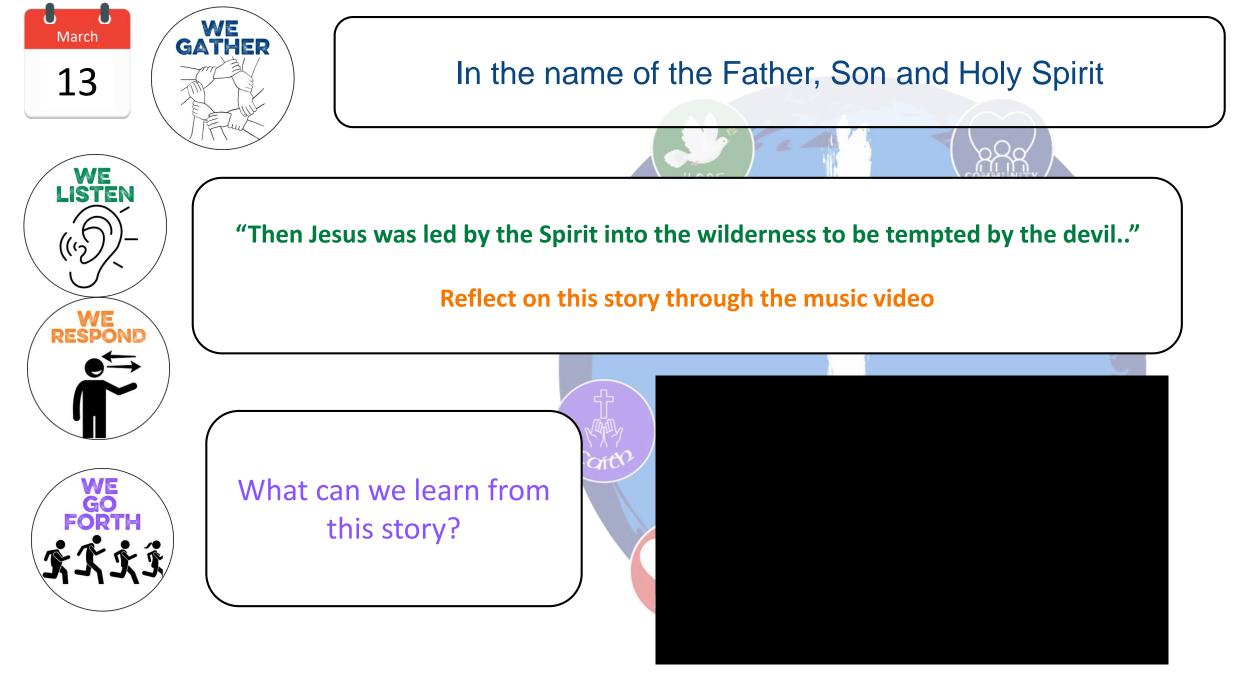
- •Sign it, then fold it and put it into your pocket.

- •How well have you kept your promise today?



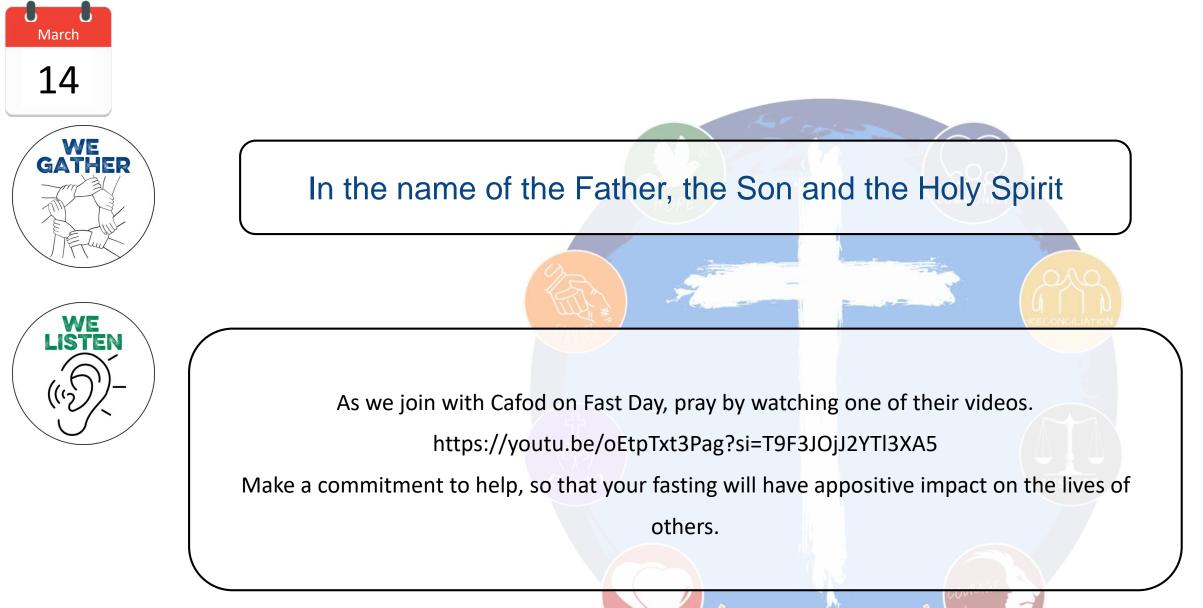
