Dear parents & carers,

Re: GCSE examinations

As we approach the end of term for the Easter break, I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our students, parents and carers for your continued support over this term. It has been especially good to see you at our consultation evenings to discuss your child's progress and the support we can all give them. Thank you to those parents and carers who attended the Eggs'am ready' event last night, we hope you found the information and resources useful to support your child. If you were unable to attend, you will find all the resources on our website under the Year 11 section.

At present our Year 11 students are working incredibly hard both in school and at home to prepare for their final GCSE examinations; the first of which is on the 1st May (although some practical exams will take place before this), the last exam being on the 18TH June. Please note that all students must be available for exams until the contingency date of 25th June 2025 under exam regulations set out by Ofqual (the exams regulator).

Yesterday all students received a copy of their personalised timetable. This timetable is also available to parents on the Arbor app. Please note that some students will sit practical examinations such as art, photography and music in the first week back after the Easter break.

We have spoken with all of our Year 11 students about their upcoming external examinations, including logistics and regulations. We are aiming to reassure and inform our students as much as possible. School has formally entered all students into their relevant exams and with the correct exam board. It is important to note that school has to pay for every exam your child sits. With this in mind it is imperative that you discuss with your child the importance of attending every exam, on time and also their conduct whilst in exams. Any student who misses an exam or is removed from an exam due to their conduct, will be required to pay for that examination. To help with any questions around exams our students, parents and carers may have Ofqual have produced a student guide which is full of vital information.
