

Listen to this piece of music called "gratitude" in silence.




In our worship this morning we spend time in sacred silence, offering our thoughts to God, being still and knowing that he is God

What is love?

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.





John 3:13-17

At that time: Jesus said to Nicodemus, 'No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

Verse 16 says that God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son.

What do you think it means for love to be shown through giving or sacrifice—and how might we reflect that kind of love in our school or community?"
