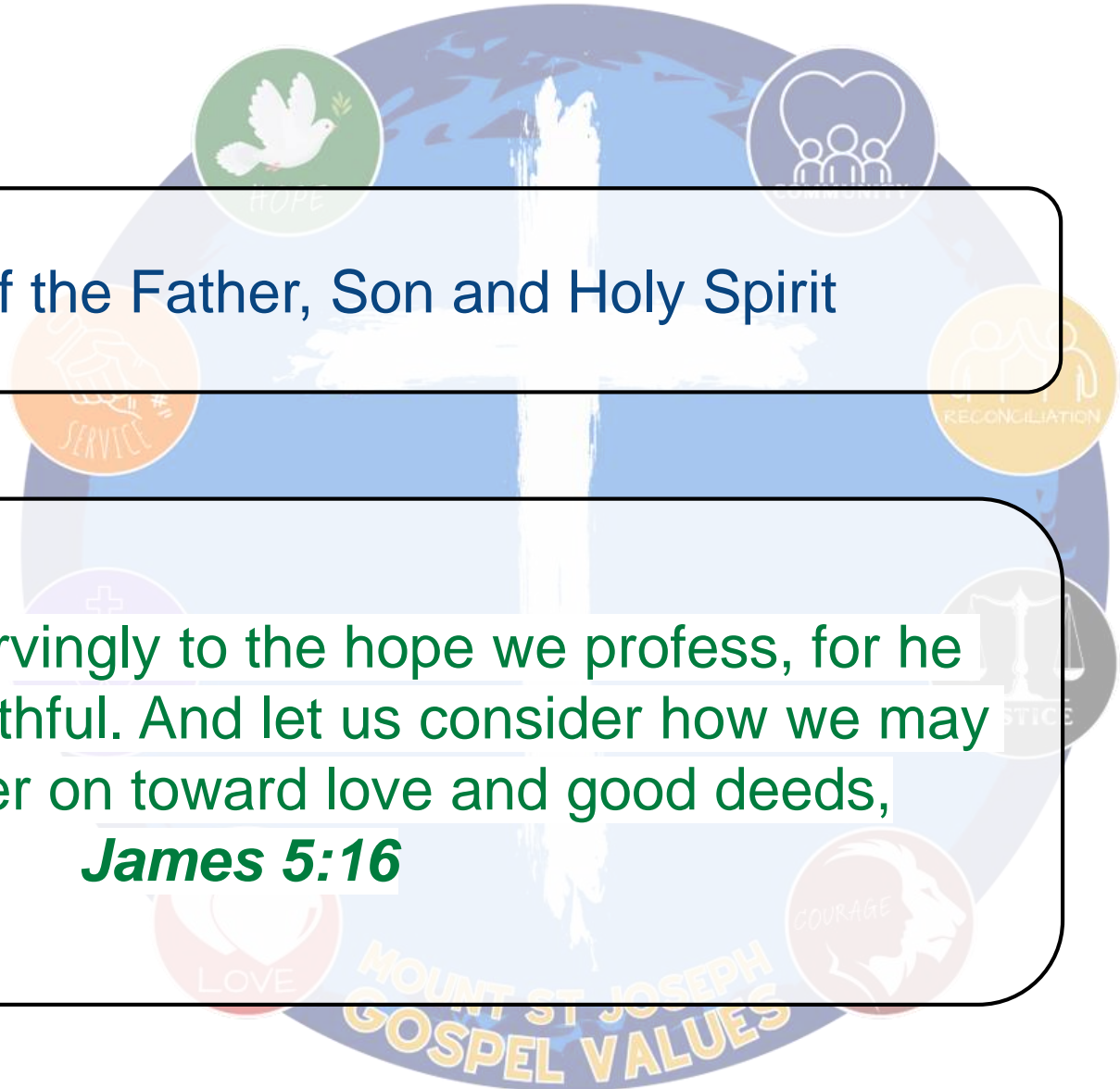

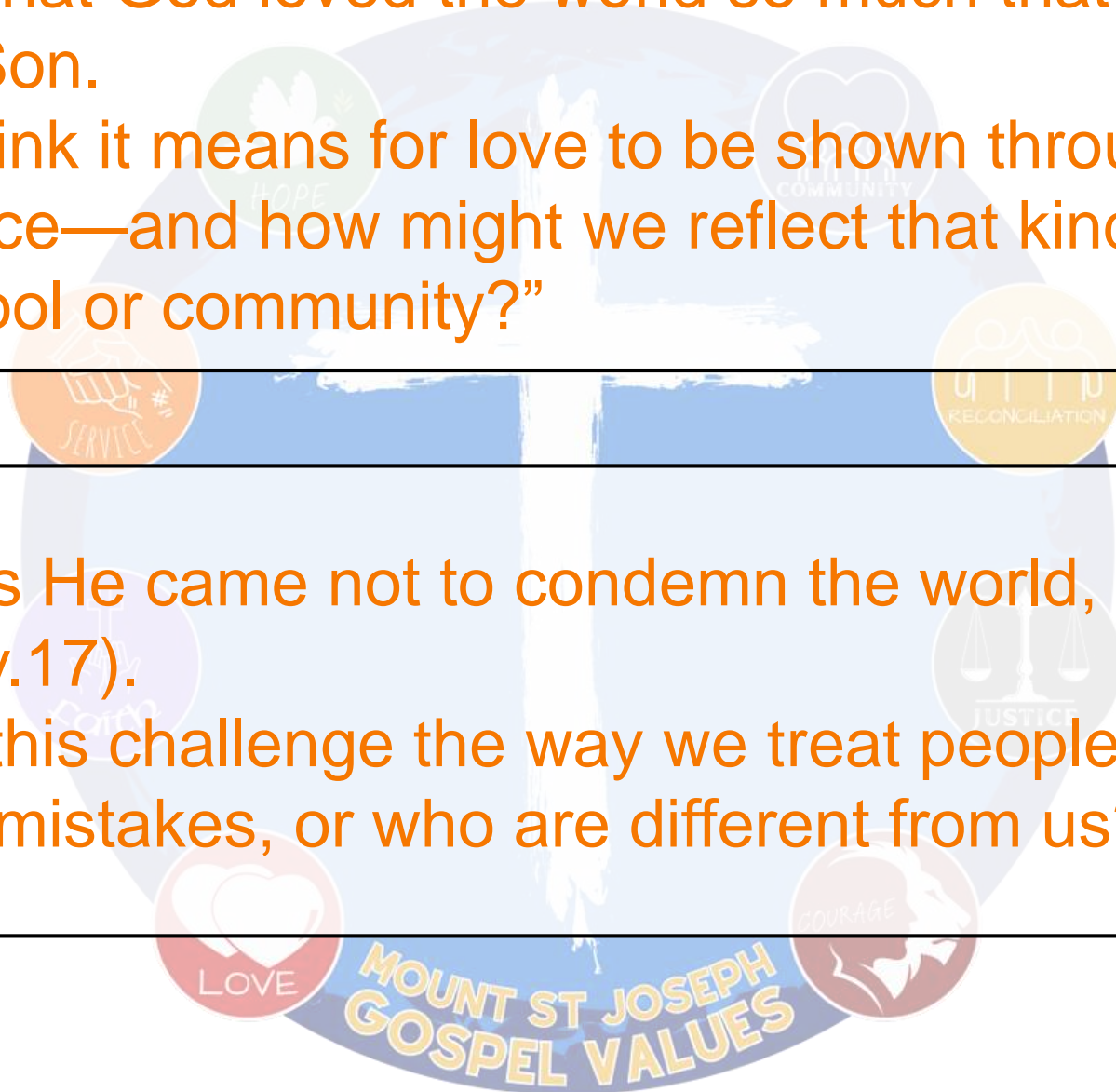
Verse 16 says that God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son.
