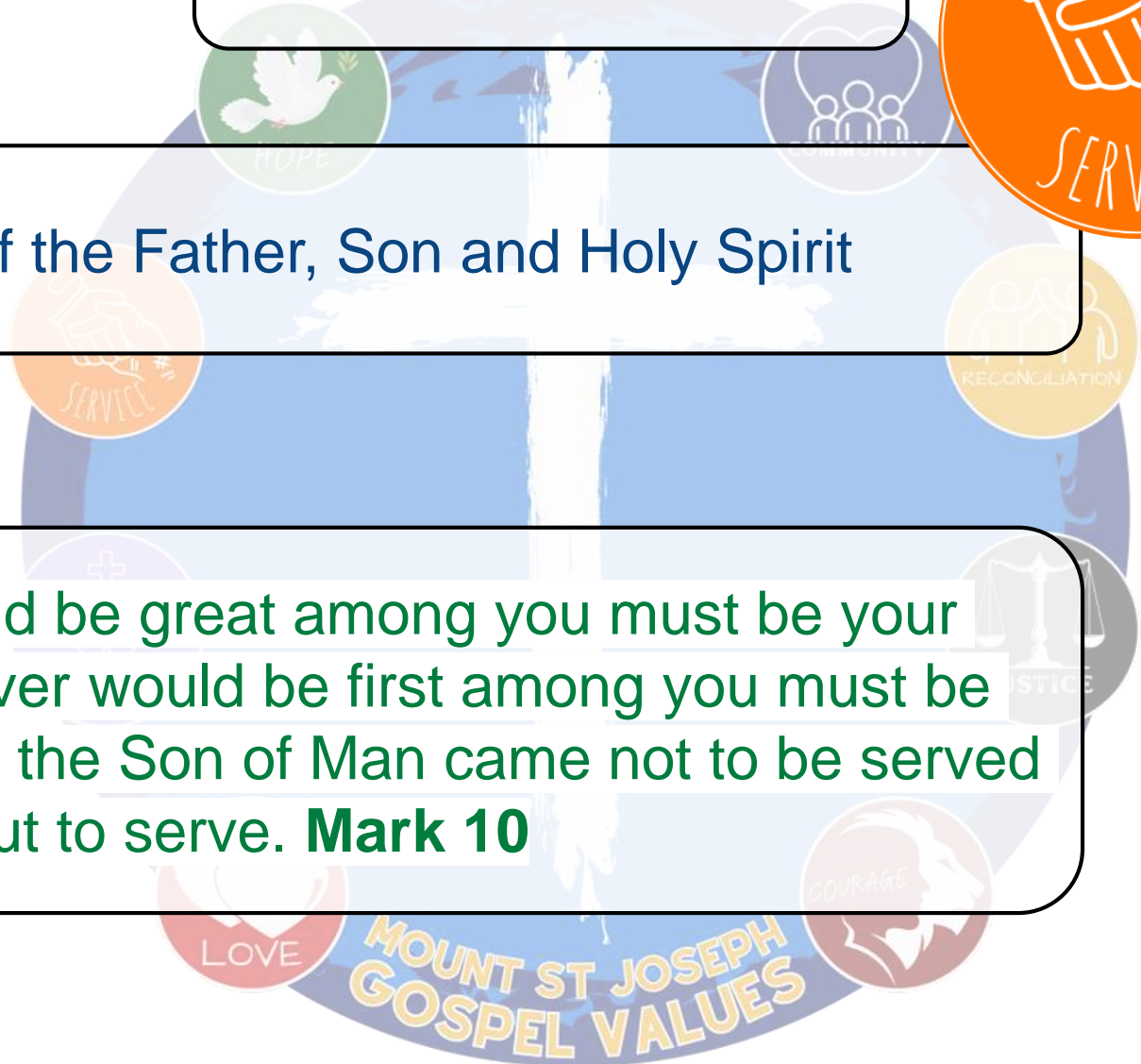

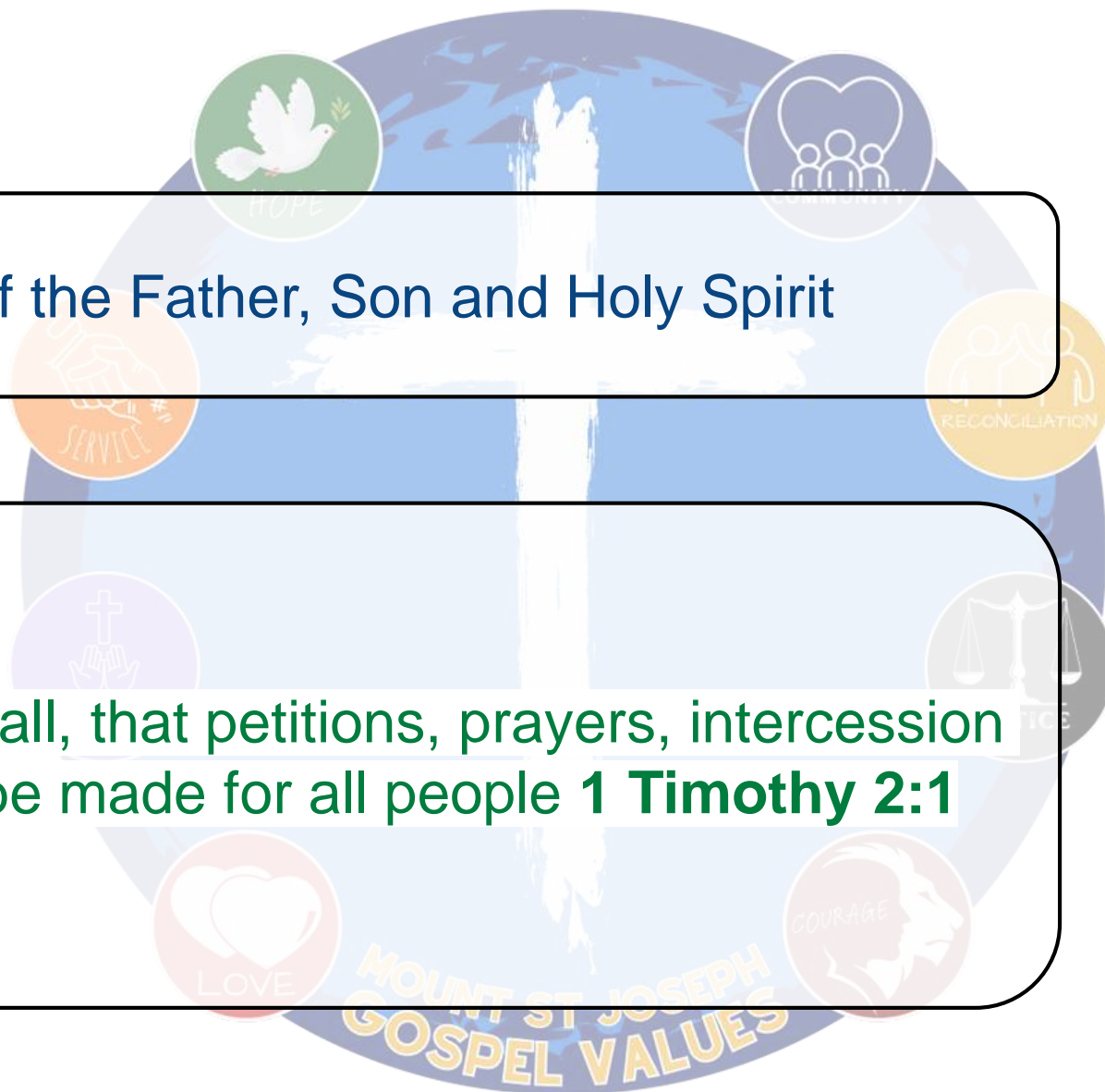

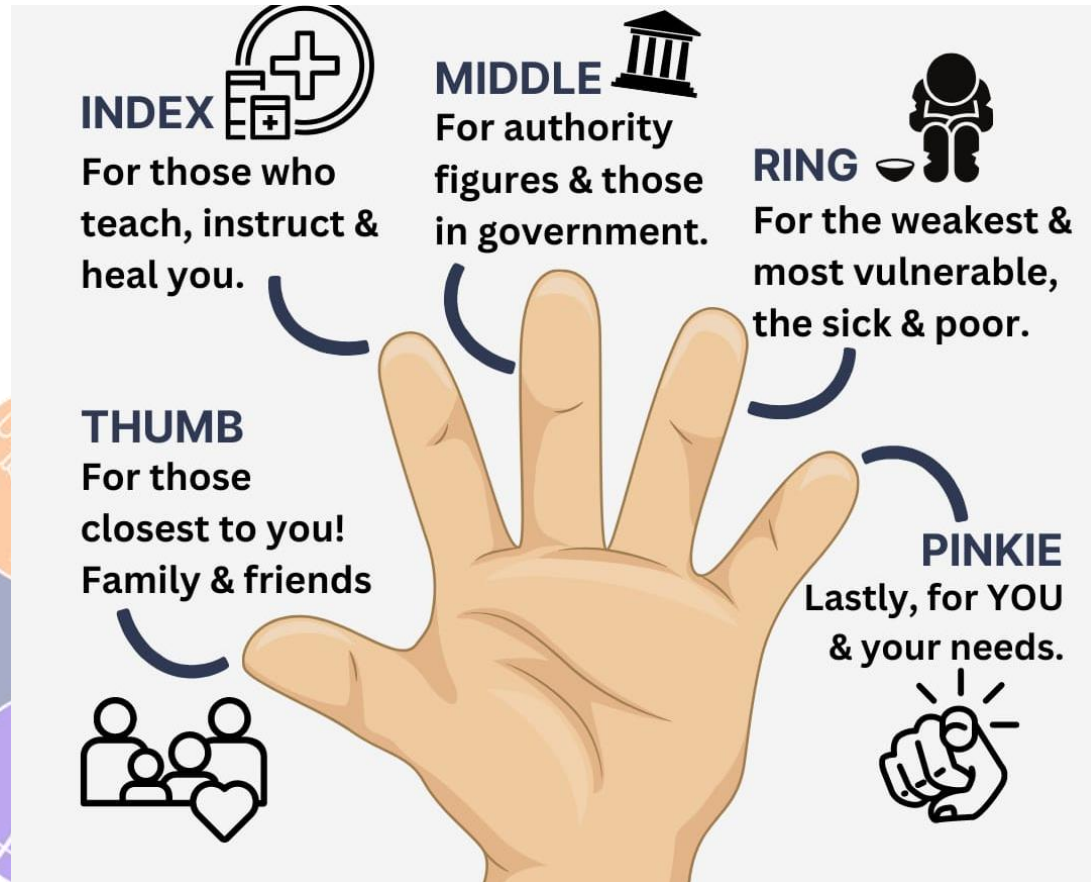

You could also write the names of anyone you would like to pray for today. Add colour and decorate the names you have written, as you ask God to look after them.

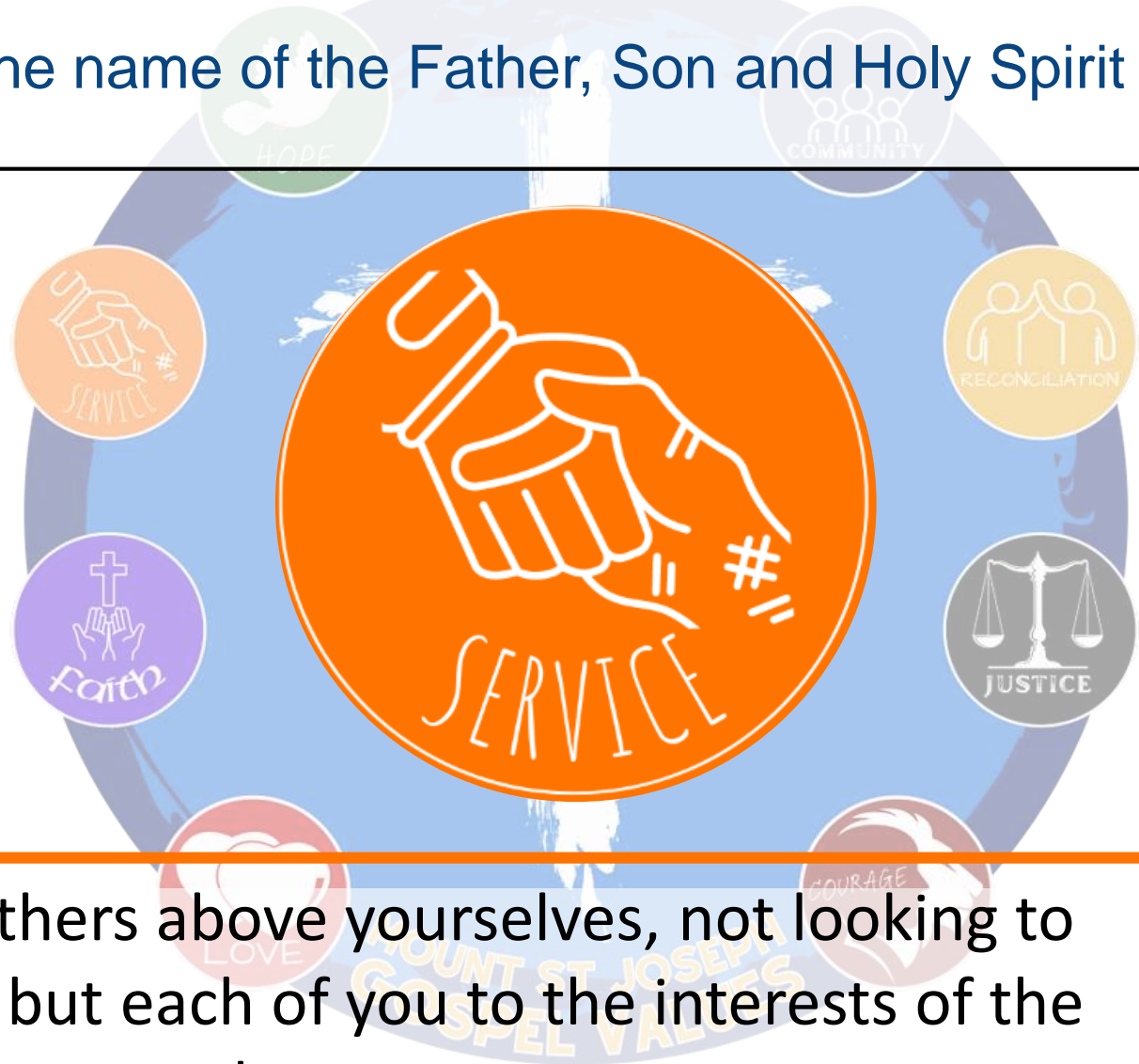

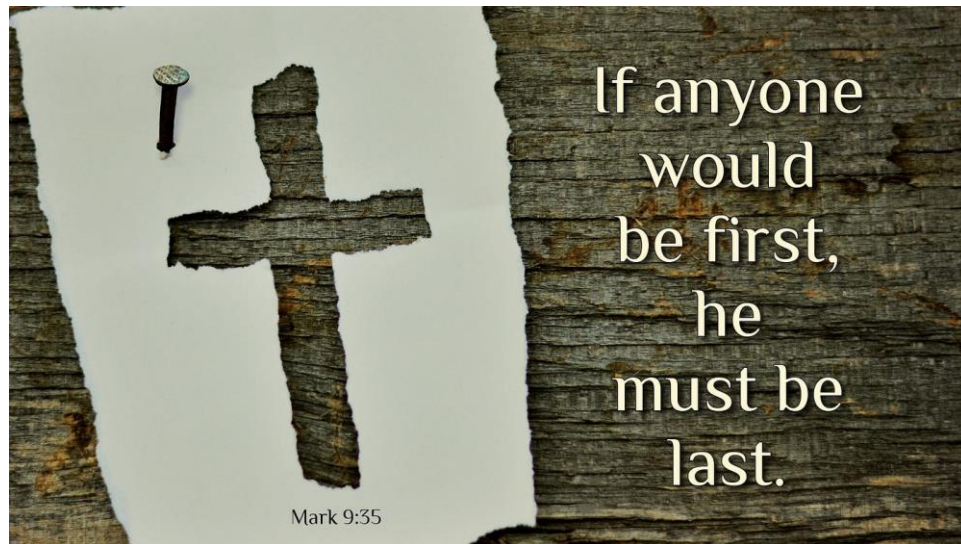

Luke 16:1-13



At that time: Jesus said to the disciples, ‘ ‘One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much, and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much. If then you have not been faithful with the unrighteous wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches? And if you have not been faithful with that which is another’s, who will give you that which is your own?’

No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money.’



Take time to look carefully and thoughtfully at the Sieger Koder painting. Let God use your senses to speak to your heart.

What do you see? How does it link to our theme of 'service'?

- Jesus humbled himself and did the job the lowliest servant would usually do. Is this the image you have of Jesus?
- How do you think Peter felt? Would you feel the same?
