As we begin, take a quiet moment to think of a time you've seen someone show kindness, fairness or courage. These moments can give us glimpses of God's kingdom in everyday life.



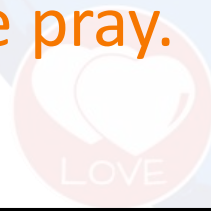
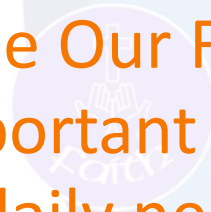

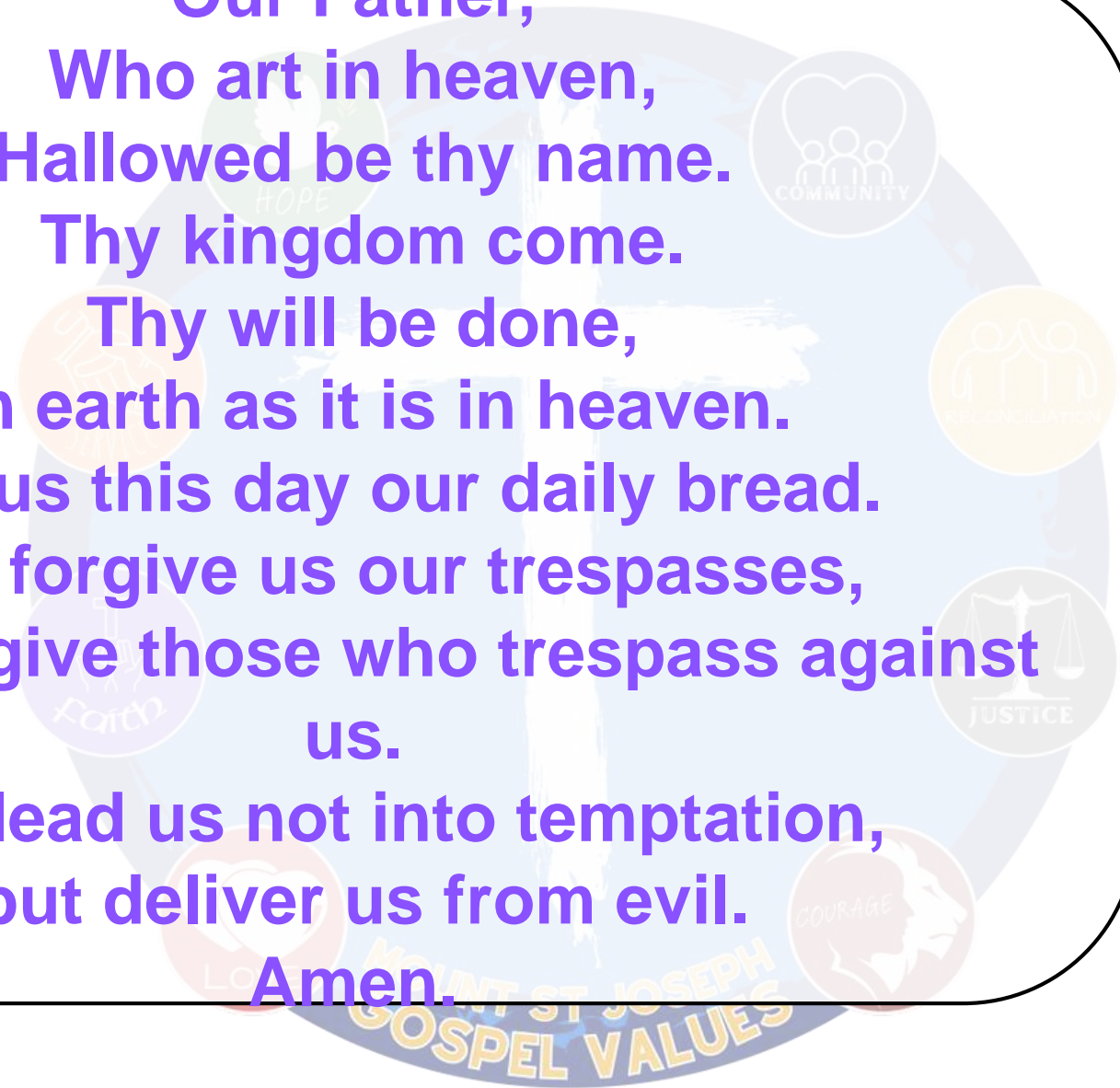
As we pray the Our Father together, focus on one line that feels important to you today — maybe forgiveness, daily needs, or God’s will. Hold that line in your mind as we pray.
