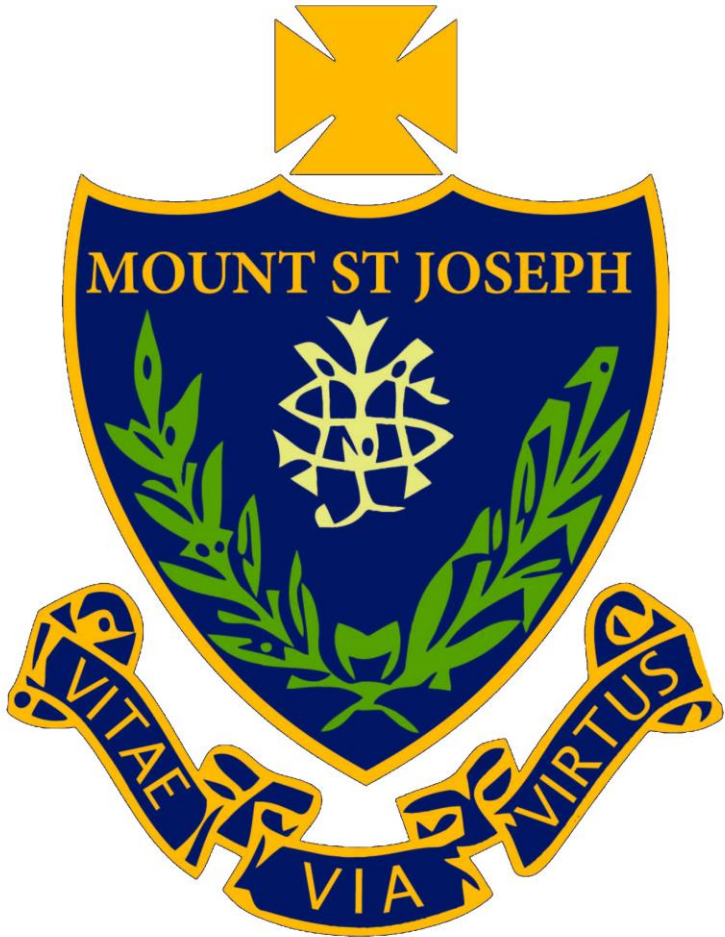

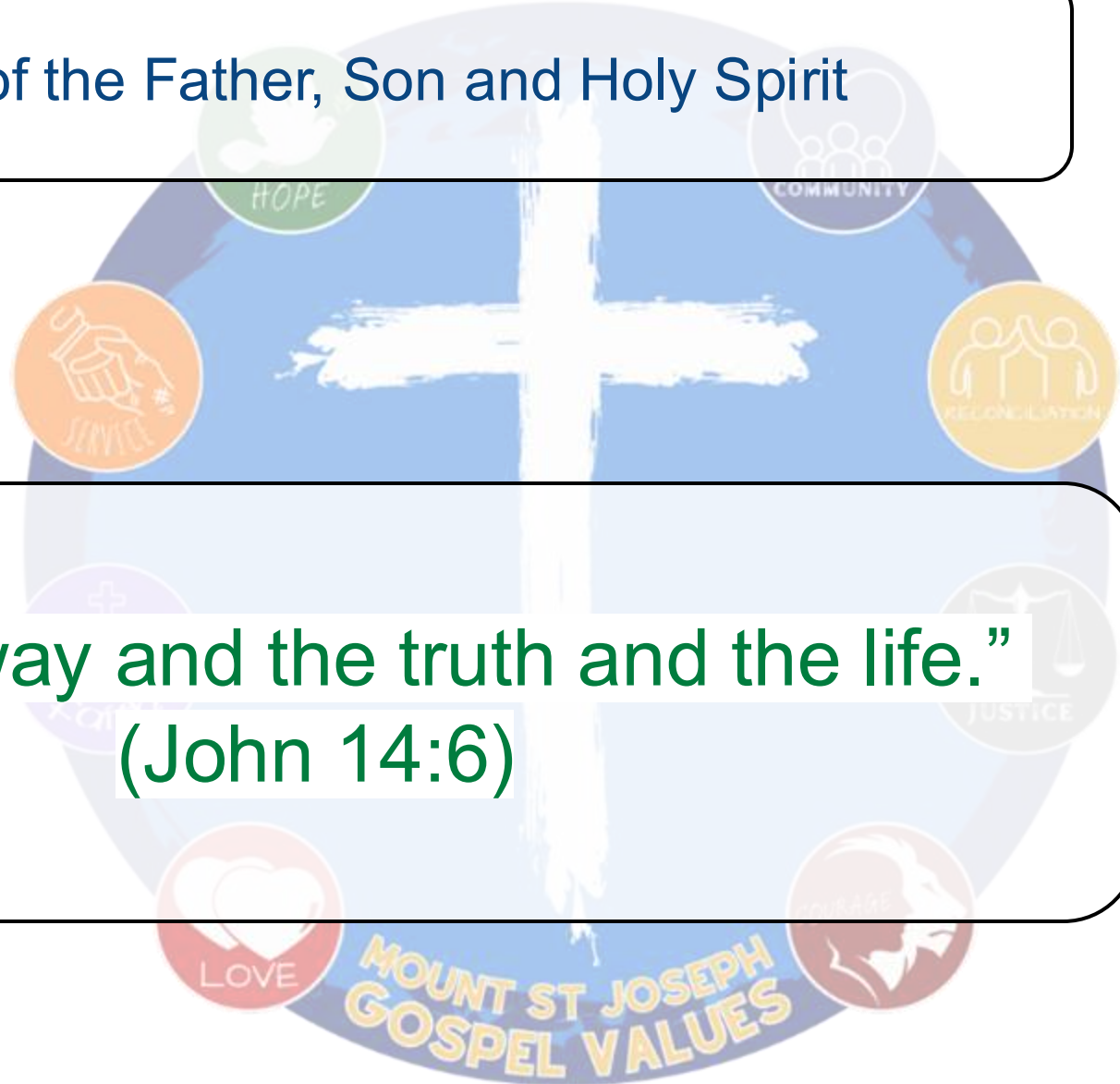

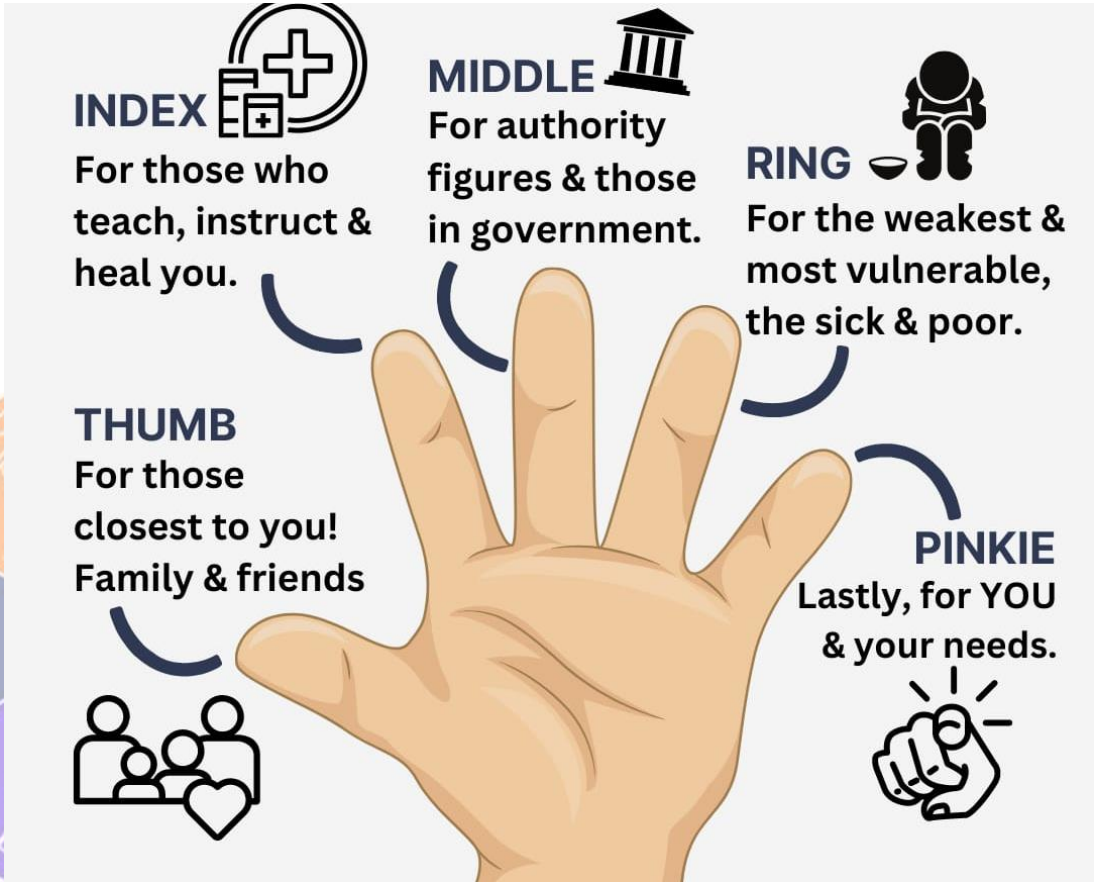

How can we follow Jesus' example this week?

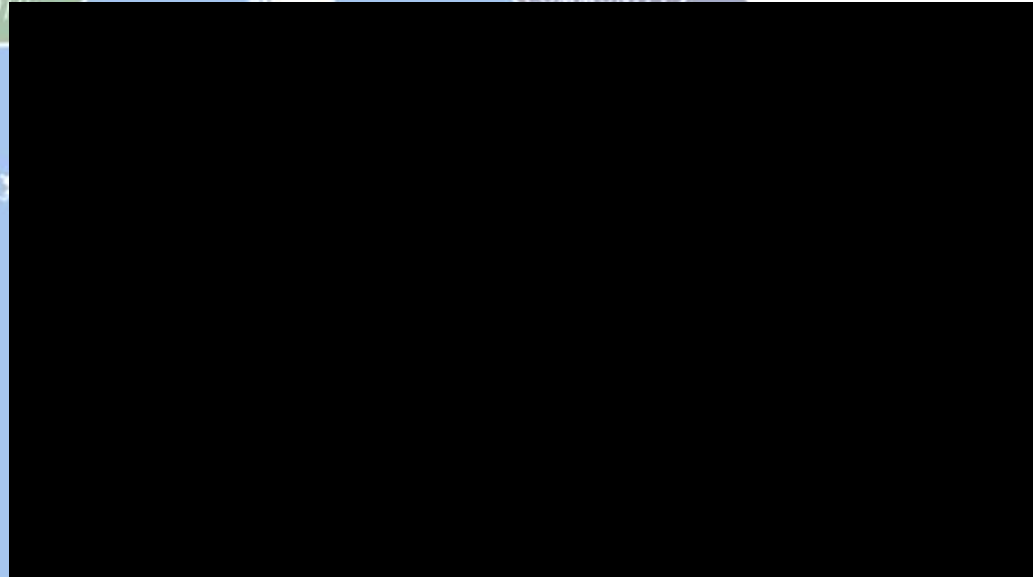
